

# Tarahumara adventure



CHIHUAHUA – CREEL – COPPER CANYON – MENNONITES – CHIHUAHUA

5 NIGHTS / 6 DAYS

## DAY 1

### ORIGIN – CHIHUAHUA CITY



- ◆ Arrival in Chihuahua City.
- ◆ Airport transfer to the hotel.
- ◆ Guided City tour to The Metropolitan Cathedral, Government Palace murals, Quinta Gameros, Historical Museum of the Mexican Revolution (Pancho Villa's house) and Colonial Aqueduct (3 hours. approx.). **Museums closed on Mondays.**
- ◆ Hotel accommodation in Chihuahua City. B.



## DAY 2

### CHIHUAHUA – CREEL (Road transfer 4.5 h.)



- ◆ Breakfast and check-out.
- ◆ 08:00 a.m. - Road transfer to the Pueblo Mágico of Creel. Creel was founded at the beginning of the XX century as a logging town and is considered the entrance to the Sierra Tarahumara. Among its main attractions are the diverse Rarámuri communities that surround the area, as well as the breathtaking natural landscapes: waterfalls, lakes, religious missions, and valleys with stunning ragged rock formations, among many others.
- ◆ 11:30 a.m. - Approximate time of arrival
- ◆ Hotel check-in.
- ◆ Van tour to Lake Arareco, San Ignacio Jesuit Mission, Valley of the Mushrooms & Frogs, the mystic Valley of the Monks and San Sebastian's Tarahumara cave. During summer raining season visit to the Cusarare waterfalls.
- ◆ Tour duration: 2.5 hours.
- ◆ Hotel accommodation in Creel. B.



**CREEL – COPPER CANYON** (Chepe 1.5 h.)



- ◆ 08:00 a.m. - Transfer to the station to board the CHEPE EXPRESS at 08:00 a.m. (Economy class). 1.5 hours ride to Divisadero.
- ◆ A highlight of the journey is El Lazo, where the railway loops 360° and passes under itself.
- ◆ 09:55 a.m. - Arrival in Divisadero and immediate check-in at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas, since the Hotel is located just 328 ft. distance from the CHEPE train station "Divisadero".
- ◆ Divisadero is the most important stop on the route, offering views up to 1,200 m deep. The Copper Canyon Adventure Park enhances the experience with its attractions.
- ◆ Lunch. In the afternoon, a 1.5 hours walk to Tarahumara cave lookout points, where you can appreciate the traditions of the Rarámuri people.  
Dinner and accommodation at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas. B.



**HOTEL DIVISADERO BARRANCAS** is a lodge that's been in business since 1973, built on the rim of the Copper Canyon. It's well-known for its privileged location, being the only property with direct views to the Copper Canyon, Urique and Tararecua, Canyons and natural access on foot to the Copper Canyon Adventure Park and 328 ft. from the CHEPE train station "Divisadero".



## DAY 4

### COPPER CANYON



- ◆ Breakfast.
- ◆ 09:00 a.m. - Guided walk through the 1.5 km scenic path that includes extraordinary lookouts to take pictures, hanging bridges, and handmade craft stands, until you arrive at the famous lookout Piedra Volada (a steep, rock cliff with a pointy edge; above it, a “balancing rock”), and the entrance to the Copper Canyon Adventure Park. Undoubtedly, these are the best views of the Copper Canyon. The Park offers diverse extreme and adventurous tourist activities for visitors of all age ranges.
- ◆ Return to the hotel for lunch. It is suggested to take off an afternoon, in order to admire the spectacular views from the lobby bar.
- ◆ Dinner and accommodation at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas. B.

### COPPER CANYON – MENNONITES – CHIHUAHUA (5.5 h.)



- ◆ Breakfast and check-out.
- ◆ Road transfer (6 hours. approx.) to Chihuahua City.
- ◆ During the trip, there'll be a visit to the Mennonite fields and to the Mennonite Museum of Cuauhtémoc city. Here, you'll learn about this cultural group originally from Canada and Europe, which established in the state of Chihuahua in 1920. The Mennonite museum is closed on Sundays. B.
- ◆ Hotel accommodation in Chihuahua City.

## DAY 6

### CHIHUAHUA – CHECK-OUT



- ◆ Breakfast.
- ◆ Hotel – airport transfer from Chihuahua City. B.
- ◆ End of services.
