

# 2 TARAHUMARA COLONIAL ADVENTURE

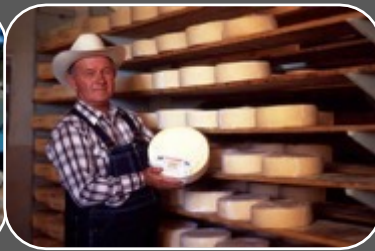


**CHIHUAHUA – MENNONITES – CREEL – COPPER CANYON – EL FUERTE  
(FRIDAY\*, MONDAY, WEDNESDAY)\*DOES NOT operate May and June.  
ITINERARY 5 NIGHTS – 6 DAYS**



## DAY 1 (ORIGIN - CHIHUAHUA CITY)

- Arrival in Chihuahua City.
- Airport transfer to the hotel.
- Guided City tour to The Metropolitan Cathedral, Government Palace murals, Quinta Gameros, Historical Museum of the Mexican Revolution (Pancho Villa's house), Hidalgo's Dungeon and Colonial Aqueduct (3 hr approx.).
- Museums closed on Mondays.
- Hotel accommodation in Chihuahua City.



## DAY 2 (CHIHUAHUA – MENNONITES – CREEL)

- Breakfast and check-out.
- 08:00 hr. Road transfer to the *Pueblo Mágico* of Creel.
- During the trip, there will be a visit to the Mennonite fields and to the Mennonite Museum of Cuauhtémoc City. Here, you'll learn about this cultural group originally from Canada and Europe, which established in the state of Chihuahua in 1920. The museum is closed on Sundays.
- Creel was founded at the beginning of the XX century as a logging town. It's considered to be the entrance to the Sierra Tarahumara. The main attractions it offers include the diverse Rarámuri communities that can be found surrounding the area and the beautiful landscapes such as waterfalls, lakes, religious missions, valleys with stunning ragged rock formations, among others.
- Hotel accommodation in Creel. Free afternoon. [B.](#)

☺ A walk through main street is recommended for Tarahumara art crafts. Also the Museum of Tarahmuara Art is worth the visit.



**HOTEL DIVISADERO BARRANCAS** is a lodge that's been in business since 1973, built on the rim of the Copper Canyon. It's well-known for its privileged location, being the only property with direct views to the Copper Canyon, Urique and Tararecua, and access on foot to the Copper Canyon Adventure Park.

**DIVISADERO** is considered the most famous and important part of the ride aboard *El Chepe* and of the Copper Canyon destination in general.

### DAY 3 (CREEL-COPPER CANYON)

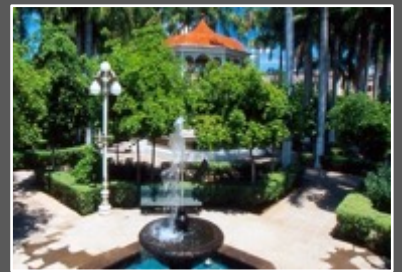
- Breakfast. Check out.
- Van tour to Lake Arareco, San Ignacio Jesuit Mission, Valley of the Mushrooms & Frogs, the mystic Valley of the Monks and San Sebastian's Tarahumara cave. During summer raining season visit to the Cusarare waterfalls.
- Road transfer to Divisadero. Lunch. Guided walk to the Tarahumara cave lookout points where you'll be able to appreciate the forms of life of this indigenous people and the conjunction of the Copper, Urique and Tararecua canyons (1.5 hr. approx.).
- Dinner. Accommodation at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas. **B, L, D.**

### DAY 4 (COPPER CANYON)

- Breakfast.
- 09:00 hr. Guided walk through the 1.5-km scenic path that includes extraordinary lookouts to take pictures, hanging bridges, and handmade craft stands, until you arrive at the famous lookout *Piedra Volada* (a steep, rock cliff with a pointy edge; above it, a "balancing rock"), and the entrance to the Copper Canyon Adventure Park. Undoubtedly, these are the best views of the Copper Canyon. The Park offers diverse extreme and adventurous tourist activities for visitors of all age ranges.
- Return to the hotel for lunch. It is suggested to take off an afternoon, in order to admire the spectacular views from the lobby bar.
- Dinner and accommodation at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas. **B, L, D.**

## DAY 5 (COPPER CANYON – EL FUERTE)

- Breakfast and check-out.
- 09:55 hr. Board the *CHEPE EXPRESS* (Economy class) to El Fuerte. This is the most beautiful scenery of the train's ride. The train will pass through a series of tunnels and bridges that will allow you to appreciate the change in vegetation due to the descent from 2,200 m to 90 m above sea level. Approx arrival 15:35 hr.
- Transfer train station- hotel.
- El Fuerte is a *Pueblo Mágico* from Sinaloa founded in 1564. It offers its visitors beautiful colonial architecture of the Mexican Pacific, as well as outstanding gastronomy. Guided walk through the town's square, a visit to the beautiful town hall and to the town's church.
- Time of arrival 15:35 hr.
- Hotel accomodation. **B.**



☺ It is suggested a visit to the indigenous community of Capomos and El Fuerte Museum.



## DAY 6 (EL FUERTE – LOS MOCHIS AIRPORT)

- Breakfast and check-out.
- Transfer hotel – Los Mochis airport. **B.**
- End of services.

- ☺ An early raft ride through El Fuerte river is recommended. The ride offers bird sanctuary and Sinaloa's native peoples' petroglyph sightings.
- ☺ We recommend to schedule a late flight and on the way to the airport, take a boat ride at Topolobampo bay to see the famous dolphin "Pechocho", and the chance to eat exquisite seafood at any of the restaurants lined up along *Playa El Maviri*.
