## DAY 1

(Road transfer 1.5 h.)

### ORIGIN - LOS MOCHIS – EL FUERTE



- ◆ Arrival in Los Mochis.
- ◆ Transfer airport – hotel in El Fuerte. (1.5 hours approx.).
- ◆ El Fuerte is a Pueblo Mágico from Sinaloa founded in 1564. It offers its visitors beautiful colonial architecture of the Mexican Pacific, as well as outstanding gastronomy. Guided walk through the town's square, a visit to the beautiful town hall and to the town's church
- ◆ Hotel accommodation in El Fuerte. B.

It is suggested a visit to the indigenous community of Capomos and El Fuerte Museum.

## DAY 2

### EL FUERTE – BAHUICHIVO/CEROCAHUI (CHEPE 5 h.)



- ◆ Breakfast and check-out.
- ◆ 8:10 a.m. - Transfer hotel to the train station to board the CHEPE EXPRESS (Economy class) to Bahuichivo. This is the most beautiful part of the train ride that will allow you to appreciate the change in vegetation due to the ascent from 90 m to 1,625 m above sea level.
- ◆ 2:25 p.m. – Arrival. Transfer train station in Bahuichivo – hotel in Cerocahui.
- ◆ Lunch. Visit to the Tarahumara girls orphanage and wine fields.
- ◆ Dinner . Hotel accommodation in Cerocahui. B.

An early raft ride through El Fuerte river is recommended. The ride offers bird sanctuary and Sinaloa's native peoples' petroglyph sightings.



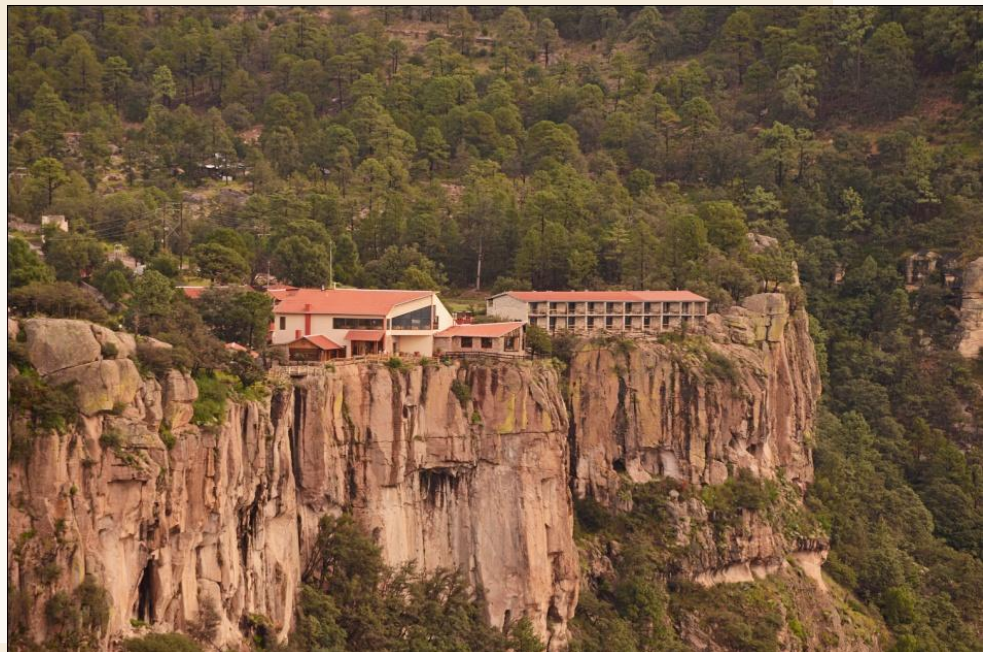


## DAY 3

### CEROCAHUI – COPPER CANYON (Road transfer 1.5 h.)



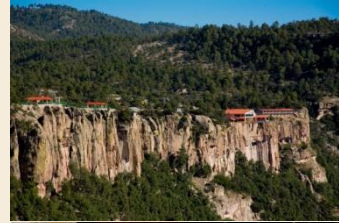
- ◆ Breakfast.
- ◆ During the morning, van tour to Cerro del Gallego lookout. Here, you'll be able to appreciate the stunning views of Urique Canyon.
- ◆ Return to the hotel. Early lunch and check-out.
- ◆ 2:30 p.m. - Road transfer from Cerocahui to Divisadero.
- ◆ 4:00 p.m. - Arrival at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas.
- ◆ Hotel accommodation at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas. Take your time to rest and view the sunset at our panoramic lobby-bar. Dinner and accomodiation Hotel Divisadero Barrancas. B.



## COPPER CANYON



- ◆ Breakfast.
- ◆ 09:00 a.m. - Guided walk through the 1.5 km scenic path that includes extraordinary lookouts to take pictures, hanging bridges, and handmade craft stands, until you arrive at the famous lookout Piedra Volada (a steep, rock cliff with a pointy edge; above it, a “balancing rock”), and the entrance to the Copper Canyon Adventure Park. Undoubtedly, these are the best views of the Copper Canyon. The Park offers diverse extreme and adventurous tourist activities for visitors of all age ranges.
- ◆ Return to the hotel for lunch. It is suggested to take off an afternoon, in order to admire the spectacular views from the lobby bar.
- ◆ Dinner and accommodation at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas. B.

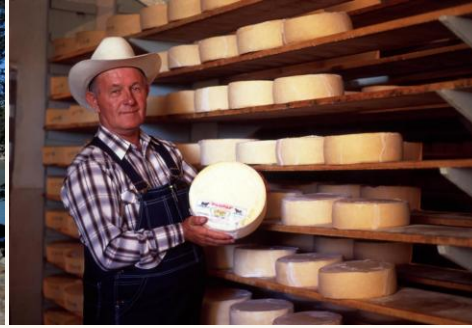

**HOTEL DIVISADERO BARRANCAS** since 1973, built on the rim of the Copper Canyon. It's well-known for its privileged location, being the only property with direct views to the Copper Canyon, Urique and Tararecua, and access on foot to the Copper Canyon Adventure Park and 328 ft. from the CHEPE train station “Divisadero”.

**DIVISADERO** is considered the most famous and important part of the ride aboard El Chepe and of the Copper Canyon destination in general.



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## DAY 5

### BARRANCAS – CREEL (Road transfer 1.5 h.)

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- ◆ 08:00 a.m. - Breakfast
- ◆ Land transfer to Creel.
- ◆ Creel was founded at the beginning of the XX century as a logging town and is considered the entrance to the Sierra Tarahumara. Among its main attractions are the diverse Rarámuri communities that surround the area, as well as the breathtaking natural landscapes: waterfalls, lakes, religious missions, and valleys with stunning ragged rock formations, among many others.
- ◆ Visit Lake Areco, the Jesuit Mission of San Ignacio, Valley of the Mushrooms and Frogs, the mystical Valley of the Monks, and the Tarahumara cave of San Sebastián or Petra Cave, as well as Cusárare Waterfall (more water during summer).
- ◆ In the afternoon, a walk along the main street is recommended, offering a wide variety of Tarahumara crafts, as well as a visit to the Tarahumara Museum of Popular Art.
- ◆ Accommodation at a hotel in Creel. B.



## DAY 6

### CREEL- MENONITAS- CHIHUAHUA (Road transfer 4.5 h.)



- ◆ Breakfast.
- ◆ Land transfer to Chihuahua. On the way, explore the fascinating Mennonite Fields and the Mennonite Museum in Cd. Cuauhtémoc, where you'll discover the rich history of this cultural group that settled in Chihuahua in 1920, arriving from Canada and Europe. Mennonite Museum closed on Sundays.
- ◆ Overnight stay in Chihuahua. B.



## DAY 7

### CHIHUAHUA – ORIGIN



- ◆ Breakfast and check-out.
- ◆ Guided City tour to The Metropolitan Cathedral, Government Palace murals, Quinta Gameros, Historical Museum of the Mexican Revolution (Pancho Villa's house) and Colonial Aqueeduct (3 hr approx.).
- ◆ Transfer from hotel to Chihuahua City airport. B.
- ◆ End of services.

On a late flight schedule a Chihuahua City tour is recommended. The tour includes a visit to The Metropolitan Cathedral, Government Palace murals, Quinta Gameros, Historical Museum of the Mexican Revolution (Pancho Villa's house), Hidalgo's Dungeon and Colonial Aqueeduct (3 hr. approx.). Museums closed on Mondays.
